There is also information about the timeline for the first new homes and where the play area on Pincott Road will be re-provided.






Existing Demolition Phasing Plan




New Demolition Phasing Plan










Existing Phasing Plan









These changes follow a review of how we plan to build the estate and aim to:


- Improved efficiency in delivering utilities such as water and electricity, plus new roads

- Reduce disruption to residents in the completed phases of the development






Timeline for the first New Homes

Winter 2018 – Utilities Diversion




High Path, Grove Road & Pincott Road


Spring/Summer 2018 Phase 1 Construction




Spring 2018 - Pincott Road Play Area Relocated

Residents will be notified before any noisy works via a letter or email.




Play Provision
